About the Estate:

Coralie GOUMARRE was the 1st woman to take the destiny of the family estate, and has been for 9 generations. Before, she and her parents as well as her ancestors, have left their mark on the field. Continuing this long line of Rhône winemakers, Coralie's joie de vivre and modern, independent approach has brought new energy to the domaine. Organic certified, COMBE LATOUR is located in Courthézon, fifty-six of the estate's uninterrupted sixty hectares are planted with vines of 55 years old on average, naturally producing upper quality and low yields.

Woman of strong character, described "strong-minded and impressively talented" by R. PARKER, Coralie GOUMARRE does research balance in her wines and wishes to give a very personal tone to her production, between expertise and freedom of creation. 1st time I had the chance to taste her wines years ago, I've been extremely and nicely surprised by her convivial approach and once her wines tasted... wow!!! Everything was clear and impossible to forget: So distinctive mouth-watering wines with a creative and feminine touch, elegance and richness. Voluptuous and sensual gems not to miss but... very limited production.

COMBE LATOUR Châteauneuf-du-Pape is created without heaviness, with a subtle expression from the exceptional Courthézon terroir and very old vines.

Tasting Notes:

Dense, silky nose on raspberry, black current and candied fruits notes. Rich and full bodied, ample, unctuous and so voluptuous palate and length on licorice, mocha, soft spices and dark coffee notes. A pure Coralie Signature and finesse.
