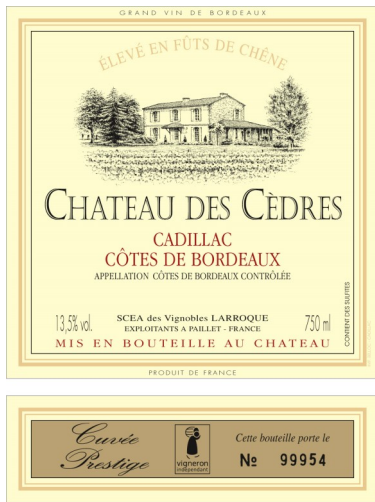

About the Estate:

The total 35 hectares vineyard of Château des CEDRES is situated in Paillet in the heart of the 1eres Cotes de Bordeaux and Cadillac Appellations. With an incredible and unobstructed view on the Garonne Valley at more than 120 meters altitude, the 86.45 acres of vines have an exceptional exposure and natural draining. Cultivated following Sustainable Agriculture practices for more than 10 years, Château des CEDRES produces very expressive Red Bordeaux, 1eres Côtes de Bordeaux and also sweet white Cadillac Appellation wines.

Just because, the words are the same to describe Serge LARROQUE upper 1eres Côtes de Bordeaux Cuvée aged in oak barrels, when we present it to our customers and professionals: an exciting wine and a real pleasure to drink. Re-considering ideas about Bordeaux, which is not expensive and can be an everyday wine with some nice potential and unique expression!

The Cuvée Prestige is made from older vines on high slopes, with some gravels for Cabernet Sauvignon vines. Vinification in concrete tanks & 10 to 12 months aging in French oak barrels renewed by 1/3 from S. Moreau, Taransaud, Vine).

Tasting Notes:

Round, ripe and so juicy nose on blackberry, blackcurrant. Very round and easy palate, nicely balanced, with soft tannins, baked dark fruits, blackcurrant and light spices length. A pure daily Bordeaux wine pleasure.

Food Pairing:

Juicy 80% ground beef, hand patted into thick burgers; or a NY strip steak au poivre. - Craig Heffley, NC
