Fanny and her husband Anthony Lamoot bought Domaine de la Garnaude in 2013, a longstanding

vineyard in Gonfaron. With great passion, they launched a conversion of the growing methods, of which Fanny as winemaker is very proud.

*"The first year of producing wines under DGC (Dénomination géographique complémentaire = additional terroir designation) only applied to one hectare of production and only rosé", Fanny Lamoot reveals. "It was an excellent wine made from Grenache and Cinsault, which we named « Frisson des Anges ». The name suits it well, with its explosion of flavours, its balance between fruit, flowers and even clementines, and its long finish (very important)... And it won the gold medal at the very first competition of the season, in Brignoles!"*
