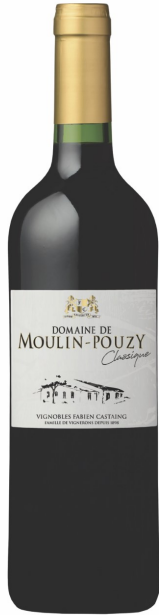


## Domaine de Moulin-Pouzy

#### Tasting Notes:

Immediately open and so generous nose on plume, prune, dark fruits, cherries, blueberries, then soft spices notes. The palate does reveal the South-West notes, with soft hearth notes, cocoa and toasted notes likes being age in oak, and it is not... Round, soft and sappy palate, delicate tannins and then a more powerful and touch peppery length, reminding the Pechamant expression. Coup de Coeur!

To be served around 16°C (60 f) with south-west dishes, grilled meat and cheeses.
