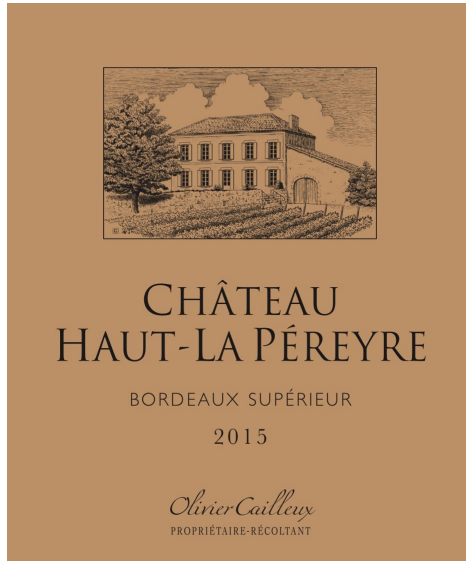

About the Estate:

Château HAUT-LA-PÉREYRE - family estate since 1881 & for 6 generations - now run by the young son, Olivier CAILLEUX - is located in Escoussans within the Entre-deux-Mers area but more precisely, in the heart of the small, distinctive and expressive Haut-Benauges appellation. Known to produce excellent dry white wines, this unique niche terroir also produces rare-to-find and remarkable red wines when the vines are planted on the best exposed and higher slopes, reaching here more than 100 meters, with a non-obscured view over the other side of the Garonne River, where lies the appellation of Graves.

We discovered and started to promote Château HAUT-LA-PÉREYRE in 1992, dealing first with the father until the young son Olivier fully took over the culture and vinification of the estate 20 years ago. Olivier CAILLEUX developed the full expression of his terroir with new plantations to better adapt the grapes to his soil and exposure, green covering, new pruning methods, pre-cold maceration, thermo regulation and bottling without filtration. Olivier introduced Sustainable Agriculture Practices as soon as he arrived now being HVE 3 certified and also having & developing Organic conversion in some plots.
