About the Estate:

Chateau Doms originated as a monastery, a beautiful chartreuse dating back the 17th century. Part of this monastery was converted into a winery in the 18th century. The old stone walls naturally maintain constant temperature and humidity.

Located in Portets, heart of the Graves Appellation, 16 miles South East of Bordeaux, on a unique gravely ridge with sandy-clay subsoil, with perfect exposure for maturity and incline for natural drainage.

Chateau Doms has been in the Duvigneau-Parage family since 1933, passed down from mother to daughter for five generations of wine growers! Today Hélène Durand and her daughter Amélie (agricultural engineer & oenologist) steer the vineyard, with long-standing tradition and also offering a great feminine influence on wines with both character & elegance.

The vineyard does now extend on 28 Ha (69 acres) within 40 plots, all around the estate. 12.35 devoted to the White Graves within maximum 1/2 mile from the estate & cellars.

Amelie Durand is impressive in her dignity, perhaps she does not fully realize the splendor of her wines!

Tasting Notes:

Elegant and fresh nose on white flowers & lily, green apples, peaches, then comes minty and grassy hints. Bright, fresh, and very balanced palate, good length with mineral, gravelly notes.

Food Pairing:

Aperitif, oysters, fish and stunning with goat cheese (St. Maur de Tourainne).
