### About the Estate:

"It all begins with a passion transmitted since 1898, which combines Terroir, grape varieties and winemaker." Following in the footsteps of Pierre, Gabriel, Jacky and Patrick, **Fabien CASTAING** is the 5th generation to perpetuate wine family tradition.

Vignobles Fabien Castaing represents a 55 Ha (136 acres) total vineyard - on the communes of Pomport, Cuneges & Sigoules - within 14 different plots, benefiting from a great diversity of terroirs, exposures and altitudes. Nearly 50 acres of the vineyard are located within the famous Monbazillac Appellation.

In addition to the great packaging - needless to say - this wine is a pure tonic, fresh and aromatic "treat" to drink! Starting with fresh raspberries and strawberry notes from the Merlot. Fresh fruits, anise notes and light peppery notes from the Cabernet Franc. All this with crunchiness and bright length and a touch of fresh plum on the finish, just a sip of South-West France!

### Tasting Notes:

RED FRUITS - FLORAL NOTES - CROQUANT - EXPRESSIVE

A fresh, crisp and very fruity wine on cassis, strawberries, and raspberries, with floral and light salty notes. Citrusy, fruity and bright palate on pink grapefruits dominance and oceanic breeze like hints.
